Entrants: Any adult artist from the region.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 for members in good standing and \$20.00 for non-members entering up to three (3) pieces of original artwork in the following categories:

1. Oil
2. Acrylic
3. Watercolor
4. Pastel
5. Photography
6. Sculpture
7. Mixed Media

For judging purposes, Warren County ARTS may combine categories or eliminate a category from the judging process, if there is an insufficient amount of entries in any one category.

AWARDS

Ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and honorable mention are offered for all categories. A cash prize will go to the Best of Show

DIRECTIONS

From Southern, Western and Eastern Warren County, go to Washington and take Route 31 North to traffic light in Oxford. Turn right at light onto Wall Street. Driveway to Municipal building is on the right, past the firehouse.

From Northern Warren County, take Route 46 to Route 31 South. At traffic light in Oxford, turn left onto Wall Street. Driveway to the Municipal building is on the right, past the firehouse.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

Any artwork not meeting the following guidelines is regarded ineligible for participation in the show.

Artwork must have been created within the past three years and not previously exhibited in a Warren County ARTS Spring Open Art Show.

All work must be clean, safe and ready for display. It must be professionally presented and structurally secure. Artwork for the gallery's wall space must be properly wired and not exceed 7 lbs. The size for wall hanging can not exceed 36" x 36".

Artists entering work in category No. 6 (sculpture) must provide their own professionally constructed pedestal for their artwork. If the sculpture is too large for existing shelf space and the artist does not provide an appropriate stand, Warren County ARTS will consider that work ineligible.

All works meeting these conditions are eligible for display. Warren County ARTS reserves the right to refuse any work considered inappropriate. No nudes.

All artwork must have an appropriately attached label, which Warren County ARTS has provided, on the reverse side of this form. Please print clearly.

All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the show.
