workshop.

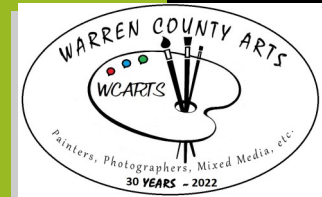
You will be guided through each
of the steps to create this soft
cover journal. Pam will provide a
choice of watercolor, mixed me-
dia and drawing paper for the
pages inside this 7 signature book
as well as a variety of colors of
waxed linen thread for the long
stitch heart binding, needles,
bone folders, rulers, xacto knives,

glue sticks etc. Your very special cover for this book will be one of
your marbled watercolor papers. Pam will have written instructions
available along with the heart stitch binding template for this 7 sig-
nature book.

In this workshop you will:

- ◆ Create a unique soft cover book 6.5" x 4.5" with at least 28 pag-
es inside.
- ◆ Learn the 7 signature long stitch heart stitch binding pattern
which can be used for soft or hard cover books.
- ◆ Learn skills to create more books on your own

Keith Garubba—Paper Marbling



Join Keith Garubba to experience the magic of marbling decorative and abstract papers with this easy-to-pickup introductory workshop to a centuries old practice. You will have the opportunity to follow your curiosity as you experience the spontaneous magic of paper marbling and also learn how to control classic, intricate patters. You will be guided through all the techniques and history of Turkish Marbling with Acrylics so you will be able to make mesmerizing designs in 16 specially prepared colors of the season.

In this workshop you will:

- * Create 10 marbled papers, 12'x19", yours to keep
- * Learn 4 (or more) cool patterns fundamental to marbling
- * Explore spontaneity in freestyle marble designs
- * Build on the skills you learn to create floral and other imagery on water.



Once you've taken this workshop. You might wonder what you can do with your stack of marbled papers! Marbling is beautiful on its own, but these papers can also be the perfect touch to amplify your bookmaking or printing projects. Your ticket to this event reserves your own marbling station, set of tools and 10 marble-ready sheets of paper. All art and marbling materials will be provided for you at the workshop. All materials are safe when handled properly, but let Keith know if you have allergy or sensitivity. This experience can be messy, please dress appropriately. Aprons will be provided, or wear mess-worthy clothes.



Keith is a professional artist with a Masters of Fine Arts in Printmaking and 10+ yrs as a Gallery artist & art instructor. Keith is the owner of Whistling Studios, an art studio in historic Bethlehem, PA where he runs classes and workshops. Website: Keithgarubba.com
