This is an Open Show with artists of all skill levels participating. The exhibit hangs from May 3rd – June 28th, 2025. The deadline for entry forms is April 26th. Artist Reception and Award Ceremony is Sunday May 4th, 2-4pm in the Oxford Municipal Building. There will be a total of 5 categories for the judging. Four of the categories are medium specific and one category is specifically for College students without regard to the medium of artwork submitted.

Artwork, in any 2D or 3D media may be entered into this exhibit. Artwork must be clean, safe, ready for display and professional in appearance. Artwork does not have to be for sale, but if it is and it sells during the exhibit, Warren County ARTS takes a 25% commission on the sale. Any artwork that sells during the exhibit can be claimed at the conclusion of the exhibit on Artwork Pickup day (6/28/25 from 9am – 11am)

Entrants must be students with current college IDs

Applications are must be received by Saturday 4/26/25 for admission into this exhibit. Artwork will not be juried prior to acceptance to this show, artwork may be rejected however upon drop off if it does not meet the required guidelines (as stated in the Entry procedure of the show prospectus). Artwork MUST be delivered in-person to the Oxford Municipal Building on the drop-off date (Sat, 5/3/25. 10am -12pm). Artwork should NOT be mailed/shipped to us. All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit. Artwork must have completed labels attached to the back of each piece. Pedestals must be provided for sculptures at artwork drop off.

There is no theme for this Open Juried exhibit.

Judging will be performed prior to the Artist Reception on Sunday 5/4/25 by 3 professional artists. Artwork will be judged based on visual presentation and control of medium. Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Honorable Mention and Best in Show will be handed out at the Artist Reception. Blick Art Materials, White Space Gallery and L.Chou have donated awards for the winners.

All students entering the exhibit, regardless if they win an award or not, will receive a 1 year membership to participate in Warren County ARTS events.

Artwork must be delivered in person for the drop-off on Saturday 5/3/25 between 10am - 12pm. Students may participate in hanging the show (12 - 2pm) if they desire. Artists entering sculpture must provide their own professionally constructed pedestal for their artwork.

Artwork must remain on display throughout the duration of the exhibit. Artwork pickup is Saturday 6/28/25 from 9am – 11am.
